REGULATION OF ISTANBUL TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

Masters with Thesis

ARTICLE 6 – (1) The aim of the master's program with thesis is; to enable the student to gain the ability to access, evaluate, interpret, use and produce information by doing scientific research. This program consists of at least twenty-four credit courses, not less than eight courses, and non-credit courses, a seminar course and a thesis study. Additionally, application study is required for arts-related programs.

Duration

ARTICLE 7 – (1) The duration of the masters with thesis program, except for the period spent for scientific preparation, starts from the semester in which the courses are given for the program which is registered for. Regardless of registration for each semester, the program is completed in six semesters at most.

(2) Those who cannot successfully complete the credit courses and seminar courses in the academic program at the end of four semesters or fail to meet the conditions / criteria stipulated for the program within this period and the students who fail in their thesis work or fail to defend their thesis within the maximum period allowed are dismissed from the university.

Courses

ARTICLE 52 - For the student (during his/her graduate studies);

- a) At least 50% of the total course credit must be from compulsory courses.
- b) At least 30% of the total course credit must be from English courses.
- c) Graduate students enrolled in engineering programs must take at least one Mathematics course.

ARTICLE 53 - For the total course credits the student has to take during the doctorate / proficiency in arts education:

- a) (Amended: University Senate 31/10/2019 - 713) At least 50% must be taken from the graduate courses of the program the student is enrolled in.
- b) At least 30% must be taken from English courses.

Appointment of A Thesis Advisor

ARTICLE 4 - The following points are taken into consideration when assigning a thesis advisor:

- a) In the master's program with thesis, each student submits a petition indicating the field of study to the program executive board in the second week of the first semester. The program executive committee submits the name of an advisor for each student to the head of the institute department to be forwarded to the relevant institute until the end of the third week of the first semester. Appointment of the advisor becomes definite at the end of the fourth week of the first semester with the approval of the relevant institute board. Advisors of the students who do not select an advisor within the given time period are appointed by the program executive board.
- b) (Amended: University Senate 31/10/2019 - 713) With the recommendation of the advisor, the approval of the program executive board and the head of the institute department and the decision of the relevant institute management board; the people who work in the university with a doctorate / proficiency in arts title, faculty members working at other universities and experts with doctorate / proficiency in arts title working in institutions and organizations other than higher education institutions may also be appointed as co-consultants. This must be justified at the time of requesting a co-consultant.
- c) No advisor change can be made within the semester in which the master's thesis will be submitted.
- d) Course registrations cannot be made starting from the second semester for students whose advisors are not appointed.
